- DO NOT park your car next to any power lines.
- DO NOT park your car underneath trees.

- Remove any important documents from your car, such as your registration, insurance, and so forth. Store these documents in a safe place that will be easily accessible should they be need to be retrieved quickly or utilized to assist in filing a claim.
- It's also a good idea to take pictures of your cars exterior and interior. In the unfortunate event of damage to your car, you'll be able to show "before and after" photos to your insurance company.
